- 2.50 Rupert Sutton Taylor starts to read minutes of previous meeting.
- 3.36 Rupert Sutton Taylor gives secretaries report interrupted by late arrival
- 4.10 Arrival of tea followed by noise of tea cups being distributed
- 4.48 Rupert Sutton Taylor reports that the new British Association of Oral Surgeons had written to ask for a list of suggestions of who would become founder members of British Association of Oral Surgeons, He reported he had supplied all the club members.
- 5.18 Discussion of where to hold the next overseas meeting Russia or Vienna. Vienna approved.
- 7.00 Rupert Sutton Taylor talks about resigning as secretary of the club. Starts by reading the minutes of the first every club committee meeting 25 years before.
- 9.50 Rupert Sutton Taylor sounds emotional and is reassured the microphone was switched off (which it obviously wasn't).
- 11.04 Rupert Sutton Taylor predicts that the club will get smaller and become very private and excusive
- 12.20 Agrees to be treasurer for a while after giving up as secretary.
- 13.15 Adoption of minutes.
- 14.10 Rupert Sutton Taylor thanked for all he had done for the club.
- 15.30 Further discussion about next foreign meeting. Vienna agreed it having been supported by Rupert Sutton Taylor.
- 18.00 Discussion of dates and frequency of future club meetings in the light of the new British Association of Oral Surgeons.
- 22.05 Rupert Sutton Taylor reports that some members wanted a club dinner at East Grinstead during the forthcoming British Association of Oral Surgeons meeting which he had refused. More discussion about future meetings and British Association of Oral Surgeons. Decided that the home club meeting should be in November.
- 37.40 Any other business. Discussion of who should be proposed as honorary membership.
- 39.50 Having proposed 3 members to be honorary discussion of who to be proposed as new members. There were already 10 vacancies available meaning 13. Discussion on the relative merits of individuals and the need for them to be up to standard. Only one new member to be proposed at the AGM, Hogan of Dublin.
- 55.50 Discussion of how to celebrate 25 years since the club started.
- 56.40 Ordering of drinks. 5 beer, 2 whiskeys and 1 lemon juice. Rupert Sutton Taylor goes to fetch drinks
- 58.40 Discussion about a presentation to Rupert Sutton Taylor to appreciate his 25 years' service to the club. Decided to spend £100 for a gift to him [£1816 at 2021 value].
